

REMOTE ART DAY: Homemade Sketchbooks

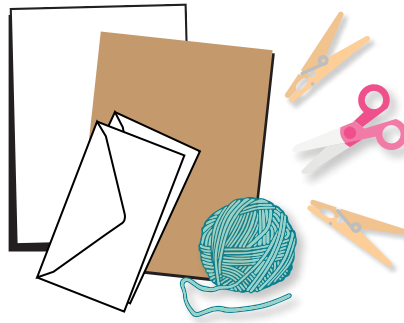
MATERIALS

Paper and Cover:

- Paper
- Envelopes
- Light cardboard
- Grocery bags
- Old folders, etc.

Binding:

- Twisty ties
- Needle and thread
- Clothes pins
- Zip ties
- Yarn
- Hole punch
- Stapler
- Scissors, etc.



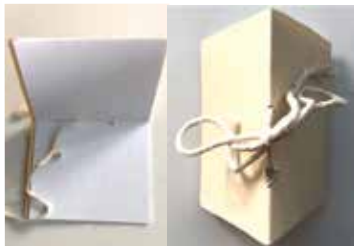
STITCH IN THE SIDE

1. Stack your paper and clip together with clothes pins, chip clip, or whatever's handy.



DO THE TWIST

1. Fold a smaller piece of paper over the end of your stack of paper.
2. Punch holes through all of the paper.
3. Thread twisty ties through holes, and do the twist!



ON A SHOESTRING

1. Place your cover material on your stack of paper and fold in 1/2.
2. Poke 2 holes in through the spine of your book.
3. Thread the ends through the holes from the inside out and tie.



EASY PEASY

1. Place your cover material on your stack of paper and fold in 1/2.
2. Staple along the spine from the outside in.



CLOTHES CALL

1. Stack your paper and clip together with clothes pins, chip clip, or whatever's handy.
